## Denver Public Library

The Libby app is the easiest way to get started with digital books, audiobooks, and magazines from your public library!

Install Libby for Android, iOS, or Fire tablets from [overdrive.com/apps/libby](https://overdrive.com/apps/libby). Or, visit [libbyapp.com](https://libbyapp.com) in your Chrome, Firefox, Safari, or Edge browser.

Denver Public Library- Make sure to select Denver Public Library in Iowa on Washington Street. In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a valid library card.

The password to your Libby account will be the phone number that was used to create your Denver Public Library card.

Browse your library's collection and borrow a title.

Please note that you may loan 5 books and audiobooks at a time and you may place a hold on up to 10 books and audiobooks at a time. Magazines are always available and are unlimited.

Materials will return automatically on their due date, unless they are renewed and there are no fines for using Libby materials.

Borrowed titles appear on your **Shelf** (  ) and download to the app

automatically when you're on Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.

On your **Shelf**, tap **loans** at the top of the screen. From there, you can:

- Tap **Read With...** to choose whether you'd like to open a book in Kindle (U.S. libraries only) or Libby.
- Tap **Open In Libby**, **Open Magazine**, or **Open Audiobook** to start reading or listening in the app.
- Tap **Manage Loan** to see options like **Renew Loan** and **Return Early**.
